## MIN 493 Ministry Internship (3 credits)

This course is centered around a living, vibrant church which offers a variety of worship and service opportunities. You will have the opportunity to pray for the salvation and participate in the discipleship of men and women. The Airdrie RP Congregation is proactive in seeing the kingdom of God extended in its community.

There will be a weekly seminar led by Rev. Andrew Quigley. At these seminars students will be given opportunities to discuss how the reading can be brought to bear in various ministries in the church, and where they can learn from the experiences of the Airdrie Church and its leaders. Besides the readings, students will be asked to involve themselves in some of the various church ministries outlined below:

**Bible Classes** - The week begins on the Lord's Day at 10:00 AM with our Bible classes lasting thirty minutes. They provide an excellent opportunity to focus the heart and the mind on God.

**Prayer Meeting** - The Church hall is packed with people in groups of eight or nine each Lord's Day morning for thirty minutes of focused prayer.

**Worship** - Lord's Day morning and evening God's people gather for worship. Reverend Andrew Quigley, a direct and uncompromising preacher of God's Word, leads us in our worship of God.

**METs** - Mutual Encouragement Times - This small group ministry has been a tremendous blessing to the life of the congregation. Groups of eight to ten people meet to study God's Word and encourage one another in the faith.

**Covenant Kids Club** - The Covenant Kids Club is a youth club on Friday night. The Club is for children ages 3-9 and runs from 6-7pm, and involves games, crafts, and Bible talks.

**Covenanter Youth** - The young people within the church have various opportunities to learn through Bible Classes and youth METs. They also meet casually for fun and fellowship on Friday nights.

**Community Outreach** - Students may participate in various forms of community outreach along with the congregation.

**Practical Service** - Students may help the congregation with various practical tasks.
